BELGIUM 1918	MAR	11th. contd.	points to the fact that he advanced in groups. At one point the enemy approached within bombing range but they were ejected by bombing on the part of our men and an Officer who used his revolver against them. The enemy went back to their trenches and in doing so suffered still more by having to pass through our artillery barrage. When the artillery fire had died down the enemy began to collect casualties under the Red Cross flag. He was 3 1/2 hours at this work. We took two wounded prisoners and a light machine gun. No damage was done to our trenches and the enemy were conspicuously quiet the remainder of the day and night. Casualties. Other Ranks. 2. Killed in Action. 7. Wounded in Action. 3. Sick to Hospital.
